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Weather:

Michimikuru lies in an altitude of 1736m above sea level with moderate-chilly temperatures and high rainfall all year round. Michimikuru is generally cold during the night and early mornings and it rains occasionally in December.

You **MIGHT** be lucky to see the ice cape of Mt. Kenya if you wake up early, but you will surely feel its **warmth**

Terrain:

The area is majorly sloppy with a combination of dispersed and clustered settlement. Get ready to walk this slopes as we minister and spread the love of Jesus Christ.

Economic Activities:

Generally Machimikuru residents are farmers. Mostly cultivating tea, and rarely food crops like maize.

Tea was first grown in Michimikuru in 1960

Religion:

The most prevalent denominations are the Roman Catholic, Methodist, African Independent Pentecostal Church of Kenya (AIPCK) and the holiness and repentance churches.

The residents are members of these churches by virtue of birth in the mentioned churches. Therefore these churches have taken root in the region.

Other information:

Any missionary with medical conditions should inform the site leaders as soon as possible, for proper arrangements in case of emergencies.

Logistics:

The buses shall pick missionaries on Sunday morning **22nd December 2024 by 8:00 am** outside the Lecture Theatres NSC within the JKUAT School compound.

Missionaries should arrive as early as 7:00am to help in packing all luggage and site organization.

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Arrival:

Once the missionaries have arrived at Michimikuru, they shall make necessary camp arrangements such as cleaning, mapping the area, and organizing visitation groups and acquainting themselves with each other.

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MISSION ETHICS & Conduct

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MISSION Guideline

1. Consult with the site coordinator and Elder for any concerns.
2. Adhere to time schedules.
3. Non-dating policy on missions and no hugging between opposite sexes.

Personal Effects	Soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, shoe polish etc. Basin/Bucket for washing and showering
Beddings	Sleeping Bag, Bed sheets and blanket . mosquito net or repellent.
Items of Clothing	Decent and appropriate clothing. (No trousers for ladies), No tight/revealing clothes. Avoid strongly scented deodorants. Warm clothing as is expected to be moderately cold. carry warm clothes especially for evening/night programs. Appropriate gear for occasional rains. Appropriate gear for morning workouts
Stationary and spiritual books.	Bible, Song book (if you can get Swahili versions of the Bible and NZK the better) pen and Notebook
Auxillaries	Electrical extensions, water bottles, umbrellas

APPENDIX : ROLES

There are functions that devolve under each committee as below stated:

Co-ordinator & Assistant.

- The coordinator is the head of the site.
- Coordinates and oversees activities within the site.
- In charge of the welfare of the speakers and the missionaries alike.
- chairs review meetings with the site leadership, aforementioned, regularly,
- Liaise with the local church leadership.

Elder In Charge.

- He is in charge of the happiness/baptismal class.
- He plays the advisory role to the site Coordinator.

Treasury.

- In charge of the funds allotted of each site.
- Advices on the expenditure.

Literature and Bible school / VOP.

- Custodian of the literature materials allotted to each site, including tracts.
- Incharge of Discover Guides VOP Bible School.
- Train site members on the use of Discover Guides and tracts.

Deaconry & Catering.

- Custodian of site storage and resources
- Catering advice on meal preparations.

Technical.

- Custodian of all PA equipment.
- Ensures timely PA set up and proper handling.

Music.

- In charge of the music sessions and interludes on Site.
- Ensures that appropriate music is used, Trains member, leads site choir.

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Prayer and Fellowship.

- Leads & coordinates prayer sessions and bands in the camp.
- Prepares devotion programs.

Interest Coordinator

- Organizes visitation groups for door to door visitation.
- Takes care of interests, visitations and appointments.
- In charge of (Wednesday) prayer and fasting sessions.
